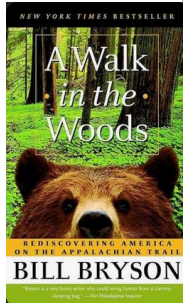

Bill Gassman will demonstrate tools such as ChatGPT, Claude, and Gemini and show how they can help with everyday tasks like writing, planning, research, organizing information, and brainstorming.
